Attunement:

Movements:

Find a partner, face center, partner on the left is "mover", partner on right is the "pivot".

1.) Partners face each other starting with hands at heart gradually opening so that arms are open by the end of the phrase,

2.) Partners change places, circling each other while hands come back to heart,

3.) entire circle moves in toward center while opening arms again

4.) entire circle moves back out, bringing hands back to heart

5.) Circle joins hands, taking one sidestep to right (head moves in an arc "circling the heart"), close with left foot... repeat

6.) taking hands with NEXT partner, partner on the left circles in front of right hand partner and continues around until the circle is facing out.

7.) circle joins hands, taking one sidestep to right (head moves in an arc "circling the heart"), close with left foot... repeat

8.) taking hands with partner, partner on the left circles in front of right hand partner and continues around until the circle is facing in again.
